This report card shows how key PHN Performance Indicators relating to aged care are tracking in the Adelaide PHN region in 2019-2020.

Potentially Preventable Hospitalisations (PPH)

Our Assess Treat Stay Program (in operation across a number of Southern Cross RACF sites) is designed to improve access to primary care and reduce avoidable hospitalisations



75 7-step pathways developed



47% increase in events treated in the facility



36 advance care directives (ACD) completed



64% decrease in hospitalisations

Our Greater Choice for at Home Palliative Care Measure supported capacity building and continuous quality improvement in residential aged care facilities
